PPC would like to comment on the documents concerning the implementation of the Market Test for the project "Pipeline Nea Messimvria – Evzoni/ Gevgelija and Metering station" of DESFA and specifically on the document of the "Market Test Guidelines", article 7, released for public consultation by the Regulatory Authority of Energy as follows:

Article 7 - Allocation Procedure

It is of crucial importance for the participants the clarification of the way allocation will be performed to the last allocated participant.

Furthermore, assuming a participant declares for a Gas year a binding capacity of 10.000 MWh/d and declares the acceptance of a lower capacity (defining a minimum of 7.000 MWh/d). The question arising is what happens if this participant is the last allocated participant for the given



Gas year and the allocated capacity is lower than his minimum accepted one.
